Trony is also an adjunct professor at New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT) teaching graduate courses (IS 680 AND IS 681) in IT Audit and Information Security Audit (2003-Present). In his tenure as a CISA Instructor, **Trony's passing rate has ranged from 72 to 80 percent passing**. In 2002 Trony's studying and training techniques have enabled two students, one from Atlanta and one from New Jersey, to obtain the highest CISA scores in their respective states.

During the past several years Trony has been involved with reviewing and updating the ISACA CISA Review Technical Manual. He was also a Board member of the Test Enhancement Committee from 1996-1999, a committee that reviews all multiple-choice questions before being placed in the CISA examination test pool.
